


Editorial

It is my pleasure to introduce the July 2016 issue of JEET.

This issue contains several more of selected papers presented at ICTIEE 2016 (Third International Conference on Transformations in Engineering Education) in January.

Our efforts to improve the quality of engineering education at several Consortium institutions has picked up momentum in the past few months, with several unique programs.

We are in the middle of a very interesting series of webinars as part of a mini-course on “Conducting Research and Publishing and Reviewing Papers in Engineering Education” by Prof. Scotty Craig and Prof. Sohum Sohoni of Arizona State University. This series of 8 webinars are intended to assist faculty to be better prepared for submitting papers as well as for reviewing papers submitted to ICTEE 2017. More than 100 are participating in this course and will receive certification based on assignments submitted.

Nineteen IUCEE Gurukuls for Learning and Outcomes Based Education (iGLOBE) have been initiated. This program addresses the vital need for institutions to develop self-reliance towards achieving excellence in engineering education. Gurukul leaders will gather at the Gurukul Summit on July 28, 29 at KLE Technological University, Hubballi in order to develop road maps and develop partnerships.

The 2016-17 International Engineering Educators Certification Program (IIEECP) has started well with eight Phase I Pre-Certification Workshops all over India (Pune, Hyderabad completed and Chandigarh, Ghaziabad, Bangalore, Kolkata, Rajkot and Madurai to be held soon). Phase II for these participants will be conducted during September to December 2016.

We believe these efforts will lead to more quality papers for publication in JEET.
