Preparations are in full swing for the Third International Conference on Transformations in Engineering Education (ICTIEE 2016) being held at College of Engineering Pune (CoEP), Pune from January 8 to 12, 2016. Selected papers will be presented in about 40 sessions. The best of these will be published in the 2016 issues of this Journal of Engineering Education Transformations (JEET).

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IUCEE-OBE Course

Phase 2 of the IUCEE Outcomes Based Education (OBE) Course has been started with 41 participants. This Phase is being taught by Profs. Shettar, Joshi and Tewari of BVB College of Engineering and Technology as well as Prof. Komives of San Jose State University from October 3, 2015 to January 5, 2016 in a Blended On-line format. The Course will conclude with a face-to-face Phase 3 Valedictory Session at ICTIEE 2016 on Jan 10, 2016.

IUCEE-EPICS Course

Phase 2 of the IUCEE-EPICS Course: “Integrating Projects and Design into Core Engineering Courses: Enhancing Learning and Preparing Professionals” has started with 49 participants by Prof. Bill Oakes using blended on-line modules. He is being assisted by Prof. Shinde of Sinhgad Institute of Technology. The Course will conclude with Phase 3 face-to-face Valedictory Session at ICTIEE 2016 on Jan 10, 2016.

IIEECP Teacher Certification Course

The second pilot of the IUCEE International Engineering Educator Certification Program (IIEECP), sponsored by IGIP, Austria and Microsoft is in its Phase 2 with blended on-line modules. Phase 3 face-to-face Valedictory Session for its 36 participants will be conducted in June 2016.
