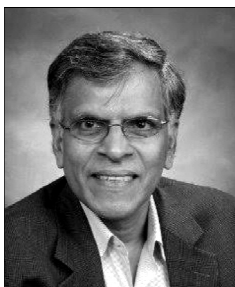


Editorial

He has a passion for improving quality of engineering education and for spreading the culture of engineering education research. He and his colleague, Prof. Scotty Craig, have coauthored a paper in this issue. This paper can provide a framework for spreading the culture of Department-Based Engineering Education Research (DBEER) in India. He has also started helping us improve the journal in many ways. Please encourage your institutional leaders and colleagues to subscribe to JEET as an important part of their efforts to improve quality of engineering education.
- Increasing submission of papers to JEET is obviously of very high priority. Please help spread the word and encourage faculty to publish in JEET.

We are soon likely to allow free access to online papers of JEET for a limited period of time in order to encourage all of the above.
