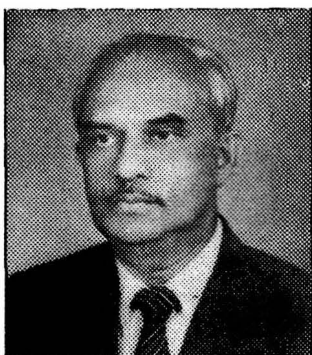


Dr. P. J. GEORGE

He graduated in Mechanical Engineering from College of Engineering, Thiruvananthapuram in 1953;

M. S. Degree from USA under TCM programme in 1960 and Ph.D. Degree from USA with UNESCO Fellowship in 1970.

He joined the same College (College of Engineering, Thiruvananthapuram) as Lecturer in 1957. Became Principal, Government Engineering College, Thrissur in 1975, and latter on worked as Principal, College of Engineering, Thiruvananthapuram in 1980.

In 1982, he became Director of Technical Education, Government of Kerala;

He was also appointed as Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and Chairman, Board of Vocational

Education in 1986.

Prof. George joined as Programme Director and Executive Secretary, ISTE in 1988 and he holds the same post today.
